Method used to choose precincts and batch of ballots to manually tally (include description of random selection method):

All the batches were printed on slips of paper and the slips were put into plastic bowls where members of the public drew. This happened on two different occasions - first for the Election Night batches and second for the remainder of the batches.

Additionally we escalated the manual tally for a single local contest that was close. We opted to do a 100% manual tally for that contest which totaled 18,459 ballots found in 358 batches.

There were 5 discrepancies noted, all having to do with the voter indicating their intent but not marking the ballot correctly. Two different teams and a supervisor all agreed on the intent and the ballots were corrected and the results updated.
