Method used to choose precincts and batch of ballots to manually tally (include description of random selection method):

One percent of the polling place voting precincts and one percent of the vote by mail batches were calculated. The precincts and batches were listed in separate reports in randomized order then assigned sequential numbers. Three clear containers with a set a of table tennis balls in each container were used. Each set representing one of three digits: ones, tens, and hundreds. The range of numbers to be determined based on the number of precincts and then the next random draw was based on the number of vote by mail batches. The number of balls to be placed in each container were determined based on the highest digit for each. The balls were displayed for public inspection in a clear container. (see additional page)

One discrepancy noted. One selection was made and the contest was crossed out. Based on review of the ballot, it was determined that the voter intent was to not vote that contest. The selection would not have been caught by the tabulators and adjudicated. The ballot was duplicated and the batch was reran. Updated report was then confirmed.
