Method used to choose precincts and batch of ballots to manually tally (include description of random selection method):

For the June 7, 2022 Statewide Primary election, seven precincts were randomly selected to be manual tallied, as we always round up. Five 10 sided dice are rolled to select one digit of our five digit voting precinct numbers. If a digit does not exist, or the voting precinct has less than 200 voters the dice are rolled again until a valid precinct is selected. Additional precincts were selected to be hand counted this election.

Precinct 33227: State Assembly District 7. Manual Tally: "Ken Cooley" vote, Computer: "Over Vote" The voter filled in bubble for "Ken Cooley" but also had an ambiguous mark for "Write-In". The contest was adjudicated to match the manual tally results.
Precinct 33227: Senator Full Term. Manual Tally: "Alex Padilla" vote, Computer: "Over Vote". The voter filled in the bubble for "Alex Padilla" but also had an ambiguous mark for "Chuck Smith". The contest was adjudicated to match the manual tally results.
