**Report of 1% Manual Tally  
June 7, 2022**

Method used to choose a batch of ballots to manually tally?

[www.random.org](http://www.random.org) to randomly select boxes of counted vote by mail ballots. Our vote by mail ballots are boxed and counted according to their county supervisorial district. Each box is assigned a consecutive box number beginning with 1.

We used the following process to select our batches of vote by mail ballots for our 1% manual tally:

Step 1 – We entered the lowest and highest box number of tabulated vote by mail ballots and then used the website to select 100 of the box numbers in random order.

Step 2 – We then calculate the number of boxes needed to cover the 1% manual tally – in this case 3 boxes and identify the first three numbers on the generated list as our first set of box numbers. We then ran a summary report to identify which contests were covered and which ones were not covered in the 1% (3 boxes). All but 1 contest was covered in the first 3 boxes randomly selected.

Step 3 – We identified the missing contest as the 5<sup>th</sup> supervisorial district contest. Using the list of 100 numbers, we identified the next box that had the 5<sup>th</sup> supervisorial district ballots and ran a summary verifying the missing contest was there.

Description of any discrepancies noted:

Precinct 35-5100 – Marginal mark counted as an undervote by the manual tally board was adjudicated as a vote for Brad Allen. Voter Intent was to vote for Brad Allen. Same ballot, marginal mark counted as an undervote by the manual tally board was adjudicated as a vote for Joseph E. Holland. Voter Intent was to vote for Joseph Holland. In both of these cases, the error was misinterpretation by the manual tally board. Both contests were properly adjudicated and counted by the tabulation system.

Box 20 – Manual tally board counted a ballot twice for the office of Judge of the Superior Court Office #1 twice. Re-tallied the race and balanced.

Box 186 – Manual Tally board counted a ballot twice for the office of Controller. Re-tallied the race and balanced. For the contest of Attorney General, Voter used pencil to identify their choices. Ran audit report, determined that the ballot was incorrectly adjudicated and credit had not been given to the candidate. Ballot was re-adjudicated to give candidate the vote.
