
Statewide Gubernatorial Primary Election June 7, 2022

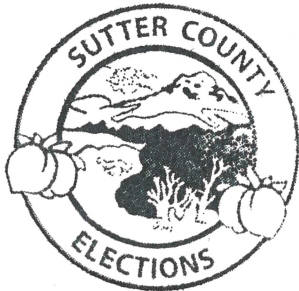
I further declare that each vote was manually tallied for each contest and the discrepancies between the machine count and the manual tally along with a description of how each discrepancy was resolved is shown below.
