Random.org is a random choice generator that is used to determine the batches of ballots that will be included in the manual tally process. 1) A spreadsheet is prepared listing the total number of batches processed. 2) Each batch is then assigned with a sequential number (1,2,3...) This is the sampling frame (the list used to draw a simple random sample). 3) Random.org is then used to select the sample using the sampling frame from Step 2 to conclude the random selection for the 1% manually tally process.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the qualified voters in the County of Ventura, State of California that the Statewide Direct Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, June 7, 2022, for the purpose of electing officers for each of the following offices:

United States Senator (Full and Partial Unexpired Term), Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, State Controller, State Treasurer, Attorney General, Insurance Commissioner, Member, State Board of Equalization, 2nd District, United States Representative in Congress: 24th, 26th, and 32nd Congressional Districts, Member of the State Assembly: 38th, 42nd, and 46th Assembly Districts, Ventura County Superior Court Judges; Ventura County Supervisor, 2nd and 4th Supervisorial Districts; Ventura County Assessor; Ventura County Auditor-Controller; Ventura County Clerk and Recorder; Ventura County District Attorney; Ventura County Sheriff; Ventura County Treasurer-Tax Collector; Ventura County Superintendent of Schools. If applicable, qualification documents will be required upon receiving nomination papers.

Official nomination documents for eligible candidates desiring to file for any of the elective offices may be obtained beginning Monday, February 14, 2022 from the County of Ventura Elections Division, Lower Plaza, Hall of Administration, 800 South Victoria Avenue, Ventura. Nomination documents must be filed with the County of Ventura Elections Division, no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 11, 2022.

If nomination papers for an incumbent elective officer are not filed by the deadline, the voters shall have until 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 16, 2022 to nominate candidates other than the incumbent.

NOTICE IS ALSO GIVEN that the ballots of the precincts of Ventura County will be counted at a Central Counting Place, County of Ventura, Hall of Administration, Elections Division, 800 South Victoria Avenue, Ventura, and shall be open to the public.

Voting Centers will be open between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 28 through Monday, June 6, 2022. The Voting Centers will be open 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, June 7, 2022.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN to the qualified voters in the County of Ventura, State of California that the random selection of precincts to be verified for the one percent manual tally of the votes cast for the June
