Method used to choose precincts and batch of ballots to manually tally (include description of random selection method):

To select the precincts, slips of paper in equal size with one slip per precinct are folded and placed in a wheel and shuffled. A random number is drawn from the wheel. All precincts in the random draw were confirmed to be greater than 4% of the total votes cast. This validates that only one full precinct is sufficient in size for the audit.

Inyo County Clerk-Recorder/Registrar of Voters Danielle Sexton announces that Inyo County will conduct a 1% post-election manual tally of the ballots cast in the March 5, 2024 Presidential Primary Election to provide transparency of the election process.

The random selection of 1% of all precincts for the required post-election audit will begin on Tuesday March 19, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. in the County Elections Office located in the Inyo County Courthouse in Independence. The audit will take place immediately preceding the random draw and will continue until completed.

The Registrar of Voters will publish the election audit results and materials on its website.
