Precinct	Contest	Issue
14026	County Central Committee Republican 70th	On a contest for vote for 6, voter marked only one candidate, Van Tran. The target was completely filled in with a line through name and target. Board counted mark as a no vote, undervote. Confirmed vote was resolved for Van Tran.
48141	President of the United States Democratic	On this contest, voter marked President R Boddie and Joseph R Biden Jr but crossed off President R Boddie. Board counted mark as a vote for Biden. Confirmed vote was counted as overvote when it was initially manually adjudicated. Difference was due to interpretation of voter intent.
29292	County Central Committee Republican 59th	On this contest, voter marked more than 6 candidates and crossed off one. Board counted marks as votes for 6 candidates. Contest was initially manually adjudicated as an overvote. Difference was due to interpretation of voter intent.
71266	County Central Committee Democratic 73rd	On this contest, voter marked 6 candidates; however, the scanner only picked up 5 because ballot was not properly marked by voter. Board counted 6 votes, when interpreting voter intent.
71266	State Senator 37th District Democratic	On this contest, voter marked a vote for Leticia Correa; however, scanner did not pick up the vote because ballot was not properly marked by voter. Board counted vote for Leticia Correa when interpreting voter intent.
71266	United States Senator Partial/Unexpired Term	On this contest, voter marked a vote for Adam Schiff; however, scanner did not pick up the vote because ballot was not properly marked by voter. Board counted vote for Adam Schiff when interpreting voter intent.
41803	Proposition 1	On this contest, there is a pen bleed from the other side of the ballot in the Yes box. Board counted vote as Undervote. Confirmed scanner counted vote as Yes.
