Method used to choose precincts and batch of ballots to manually tally (include description of random selection method):

Method: Simple Random Sampling

All precinct numbers were written on balls, placed in a bag and mixed thoroughly. A canvass board member was chosen at random to pull balls (precinct numbers) from the bag. These numbers were assigned to the list of contests in a top down order according to their appearance on the ballot. If the precinct number chosen was not represented in any of the current or remaining contest, the number was set aside and random draw proceeded until the next precinct to contest match was found. This procedure continued until every contest was assigned a precinct.

Tabulator 21-43 indicated a count of 15, whereas the canvass board counted 16. After a review of the ballot, it was determined that the ICC did not read the mark as it was completely out of the oval detection area. Voter did not mark the ballot correctly.

Notice of Date and Place of Random Selection of Precincts for 1% Manual Tally for the March 5, 2024 Presidential Primary Election

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, pursuant to Elections Code §15360, the elections official is required to conduct a public manual tally of the ballots tabulated by voting system devices, including vote by mail voters' ballots, in one percent of the precincts chosen at random by the elections official. If one percent of the precincts are less than one whole precinct, the tally shall be conducted in the one precinct chosen at random by the elections official. In addition to the one percent manual tally, the elections official shall, for each race not included in the initial group of precincts selected at random, count one additional precinct and the additional precinct(s) shall apply only to the race(s) not previously counted.
