November 4, 2025 Statewide Special Election

The public is invited to observe as the Alpine County Registrar of Voters conducts a series of public events related to the election. All events will take place at the Alpine County Registrar of Voters office, 99 Water St, Markleeville according to the following schedule:

<p>September 29, 2025 – Logic and accuracy testing of the County's high-speed ballot scanners and vote tabulation system begins at 3 pm</p>
<p>October 6, 2025 – Logic and accuracy testing of the County's high-speed ballot scanners and vote tabulation system begins at 3 pm</p>
<p>October 20, 2025 – Logic and accuracy testing of the County's high-speed ballot scanners and vote tabulation system begins at 3 pm</p>
<p>November 4, 2025 - Ballots retrieved each hour from United States Postal Service. Polls open at 7 am and close at 8 pm and the release of results will begin shortly thereafter.</p>
<p>November 13, 2025 – Ballots postmarked by Election Day and received by E+7 counted; random precinct selection for the one percent manual tally of ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners takes place at 11 am</p>
<p>November 19, 2025– Logic and accuracy testing of the County's high-speed ballot scanners and vote tabulation system begins at 2 pm</p>
