Method used to choose precincts and batch of ballots to manually tally (include description of random selection method):

To select the precincts, slips of paper in equal size with one slip per precinct are folded and placed in a wheel and shuffled. A random number is drawn from the wheel by one of the Audit Board Members. The random precinct drawn was confirmed to be at least 2% of the total votes cast (selected precinct = 11% of casted ballots). This validates that only one full precinct is sufficient in size for the full-ballot audit.

Inyo County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters Danielle Sexton announces that Inyo County will conduct a 1% post-election manual tally of the ballots cast in the November 4, 2025, Statewide Special Election to provide transparency of the election process.

The random selection of 1% of all precincts for the required post-election audit will begin on Wednesday November 19, 2025, at 9 a.m. in the County Elections Office located in the Inyo County Courthouse in Independence. The audit will take place immediately preceding the random draw. The audit will continue each day from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. until it is completed.
