Subject: Random Selection of 1% of Precincts for Manual Tally

Applicable Code Section: E.C. § 15360

Purpose: To randomly select one percent (1%) of the voting precincts for the manual tally.

Policy: The Registrar of Voters shall use a method acceptable to the Secretary of State to randomly choose the initial precincts subject to the public manual tally. The selection of one percent (1%) of the voting precincts for all elections shall be a public process. The ROV shall provide a minimum of five-day public notice of the time and place of the selection of the precincts to be tallied (prior to the manual tally) and time and place of conducting the manual tally.

Materials needed: Table of voting precincts, four 10-sided dice

Procedure:

In accordance with E.C. §15360, during the official canvass of every election, the ROV will conduct a public manual tally of the ballots tabulated in 1% of the precincts chosen at random by the Registrar or his/her designee utilizing the following steps:

- 1) Determine the total number of precincts in the election, including zero voter and mail ballot precincts. Select enough dice to cover the highest number of precincts. For example, if there are 1,439 precincts – four dice are needed, if there are 658 precincts – three dice are needed, if there are 77 precincts – 2 dice are needed, and if there are 8 precincts – only one die is needed.
- 2) Depending on the number of dice, take the maximum possible number of unique combinations of rolls (10,000 for four dice; 1,000 for three dice; 100 for two dice; and 10 for one die) and divide that number by the number of precincts. Round the result down to the nearest whole number. This will be the number of distinct, non-repeating numbers to be assigned to each precinct for the random number selection process. Using the large election above with 1,439 precincts as an example, each precinct gets 6 numbers (10,000 divided by 1,439 equals 6.949 which rounds to 6). The first precinct gets numbers 0000 through 0005. The next precinct gets 0006 through 0011. Continue to all precincts have six-number ranges. Any unused range of numbers up to 9999 will be designated as a reroll of the dice.

- 3) A spreadsheet of all precinct numbers will be placed on a table located in a place accessible to public viewing. Each precinct on the spread sheet will have a corresponding range of numbers (as determined in steps 1 and 2 above) next to it in order to facilitate the random selection of each precinct to be tallied manually.
- 4) The Registrar, or his/her designee, shall roll the number of 10 sided dice associated with the number of precincts one at a time to select a random number. Once a number is selected, the corresponding precinct whose number range contains that number shall be the "randomly selected precinct" to be tallied.
- 5) The process in 4 (above) will be repeated until 1% of the precincts are selected.


