EC 20313.a.2.B

Rolling one or more fair 10-sided dice to identify each digit of the sequential number, starting with the highest value (left-most) digit. For any die roll that returns a number higher than one available for that digit, the elections official shall re-roll the die for that digit before proceeding to the next digit. Repeat this process for any additional tally item. Example: There are 123 possible precincts to select from. The elections official first rolls a die for the hundreds place digit, rolling until they get the number 0 or 1. They proceed to roll for the tens place digit and then the ones place digit. When that process is complete, they begin new die rolls to identify a second precinct to tally, and so on.

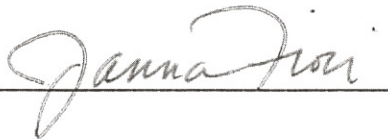

Method used to choose precincts and batch of ballots to manually tally (include description of random selection method):

Excel Rand()*100 function used to sort Vote Center batches. The top 2 were selected. The result is that 4.88% of all in-person batches were audited, and a total of 13.63% of all in-person ballots.

As for Vote by Mail, a batch manifest was kept in excel. The same Rand()*100 function was used for each VBM batch. The top 4 were selected. These 4 batches (2.14% of all batches), resulted in a manual count of 2.02% of all Vote by Mail ballots.

A total manual count of 3.02% of all ballots cast was performed.

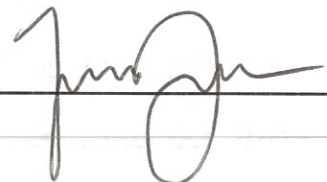
