Method used to choose precincts and batch of ballots to manually tally (include description of random selection method):

In accordance with CA EC 15360 as specified in regulations adopted by the Secretary of State, the procedure use three sets of balls numbered from 0 to 9 and one set of balls numbered 0 and 1. Each set represents one of the digits (ones, tens, hundreds, and thousands) in the sequence number assigned to election vote centers or in the number designating a mail ballot batch. When the balls drawn randomly generate a valid vote center or mail ballot batch number, the number will be recorded on the random draw results form. If a ball drawn randomly would generate a non-existent number, this vote center or mail ballot batch number will be redrawn. This process is repeated until the predetermined number, 1% of the vote center or mail ballot batches, has been selected.
