Random.org is a random choice generator that is used to determine the batches of ballots that will be used in the manual tally process. 1) A spreadsheet is prepared listing the total number of batches processed. 2) Each batch is then assigned with a sequential number (1,2,3...) This is the sampling frame (the list used to draw a simple random sample). 3) Random.org is then used to select the sample using the sampling frame from Step 2 to conclude the random selection for the 1% manual tally process.
