Method used to choose precincts and batch of ballots to manually tally (include description of random selection method):

The number of election day precincts (938) and the number of vote by mail batches (679) were accounted for in the election night final results. Election Day Precinct batches were selected by rolling three different colored 10-sided dice, one representing the hundreds place, one representing the tens place, and one representing the ones place. 10 polling place batches were selected, invalid rolls outside of the range were discarded. Vote By Mail batches were selected using the same method. 7 vote by mail batches were selected, invalid rolls outside of the range were discarded. An additional vote by mail batch was selected to account for the Alameda BOE Area 7 contest.

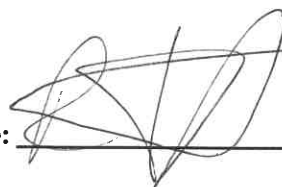

PUBLIC DRAWING TO BE HELD FOR MANUAL BALLOT COUNT

On **Wednesday, June 3, 2026** the Contra Costa Elections Division will hold a public drawing to select the precincts that will be manually counted from the June 2, 2026 Statewide Direct Primary Election. The drawing will be held at 9:00 am at the Elections Division Office located at 555 Escobar Street in Martinez.

After each election, one percent of ballots cast are selected at random, counted by hand and compared to the count produced by the scanners to verify that votes were tabulated correctly. The process of retrieval, manual counting, and verification is performed throughout the canvassing period. This process is mandated and prescribed by Election Code 15360.

The one percent manual tally is a transparent process that the public is invited to observe.

Visitors are asked to check-in at the Elections lobby. For more information, call 925-335-7800.

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One Percent Report

Pursuant to Elections Code 15360, Contra Costa County Elections Division conducted a one percent manual tally of results for the June 2, 2026 Statewide Direct Primary Election.

The random selection of precincts and vote by mail batches was conducted at the Elections Division on Wednesday, June 3rd at 9:00 AM. 7 vote by mail batches and 10 precincts (10 election-day batches) were drawn. One additional election-day batch was selected to account for the Alameda Board of Education, Area 7 contest.
