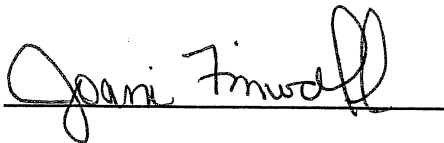

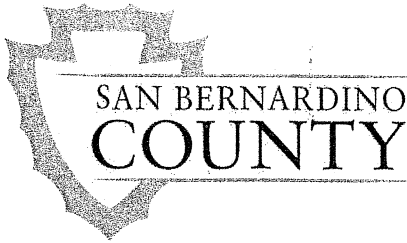

Observation Schedule

June 2, 2026, Statewide Direct Primary Election

The public is invited to observe as the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters conducts a series of public events related to the election. All events will take place at the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters office according to the following schedule:

- **April 30, 2026**
 - Election Observer Training begins at 8 a.m. and will be completed prior to the start of the Logic and Accuracy Testing.
 - Logic and Accuracy Testing of the County's ballot scanners and vote tabulation system begins at 9 a.m.
- **May 4, 2026** – Processing of mail ballot return envelopes begins at 9 a.m. and is performed daily, Monday through Friday, until the daily workload is complete.*
- **May 11, 2026** – Extraction and processing of mail ballots begins at 9 a.m. and is performed daily, Monday through Friday, until the daily workload is complete.*
- **May 22, 2026** – Supplemental Logic and Accuracy Testing of the County's ballot scanners and vote tabulation system begins at 1 p.m.
- **May 26, 2026** – Counting of mail ballots begins at 8 a.m. and continues periodically, Monday through Friday, until the daily workload is complete.*
- **June 2, 2026** – The counting of polling place ballots begins shortly after the polls close at 8 p.m. and continues until complete.
- **June 3, 2026** – The official canvass begins at 8 a.m. and will be completed on July 2, 2026.

JUNE 2, 2026, STATEWIDE DIRECT PRIMARY ELECTION

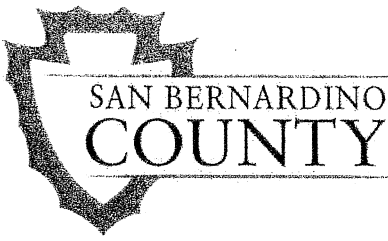
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- **June 4, 2026** – The random precinct selection for the one percent manual tally of polling place ballots counted on the ballot scanners takes place at 10:30 a.m.
- **June 10, 2026**
 - The one percent manual tally of ballots counted on the ballot scanners begins at 9 a.m. and is performed daily, Monday through Friday, until complete.*
 - The random batch selection for the one percent manual tally of mail ballots counted on the ballot scanners takes place at 2 p.m.

Summary Report for 1% Manual Tally Process

Statewide Direct Primary Election – June 2, 2026

Introduction

During the official canvass of every election in which a voting system is used, the elections official shall conduct a one-percent manual tally which is a hand count of a random sample of 1% of the precincts and 1% of the mail ballots cast in the election. The purpose of this procedure is to verify the accuracy of the automated machine count. ~ Elections Code §15360

Precinct Selection

- 1% of the precincts in the election will be chosen at random. If 1% of the precincts is less than a whole precinct, the tally will be conducted in that one randomly chosen precinct.

Mail Ballot Batches Selection

- 1% of the mail ballots cast in the election and received no later than 7 days after Election. The batches will be randomly chosen.

3. Writes down on a tally sheet the final count of the votes cast that are provided by the counters and confirmed by the team leader.

- **Two Scribes**

1. Count the ballots to obtain the total count for the selected precinct(s) and mail ballot box(es).
2. Count the votes cast for a specified candidate in a specified contest, measure, or proposition as directed by team leader.
3. Write down on a tally sheet the final count of the votes cast that are provided by the counters and confirmed by the team leader.
