Method used to choose precincts and batch of ballots to manually tally (include description of random selection method):

The manual tally sample drawing is split into two methods: Vote By Mail (VBM) batches and Polling Place batches. For each voting method the initial draw is 1% of the election night total. Additional batches will be selected to cover all contests in the election not included in the 1%. A list of polling places numbered 1 - 63 is used to determine the polling places selected in the random. A random number generator (random.org) is used to select the required number of batches for Poll ballots and another random for VBM. The numbers tie to the polling place (PP) or the VBM batch (box) number. An Election Management System report is used to determine the number contests not covered in the initial draw. The random number list is used to identify the next cross reference number.
