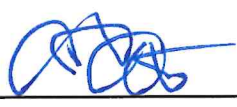

Shasta County Elections Office Announces One Percent Manual Tally Notice

Pursuant to California Elections Code Section 15360, Clint Curtis, Shasta County Clerk and Registrar of Voters, announces that the manual tally for the June 2, 2026, Statewide Direct Primary Election and Congressional District I Special Election will begin on June 11, 2026, at or after 9:00 a.m. and will continue until completed. The manual tally will be conducted at 1643 Market Street, Redding.

The method selected by Clint Curtis is the manual table tennis ball selection method, a randomization technique referenced in California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Division 7, Chapter 4.7, relating to the one percent manual tally. According to Curtis, a computer programmer and current clerk and registrar of voters, the table tennis method, rather than a computer-generated selection, "ensures a truly random selection of precincts for the manual tally, providing an additional layer of transparency to the audit process."
