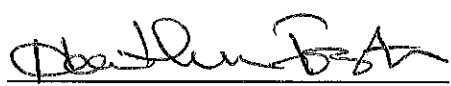

JUNE 2, 2026, STATEWIDE DIRECT PRIMARY ELECTION 1% MANUAL TALLY

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to Elections Code §15360 the Sierra County Elections Department will randomly select the precincts to be tallied and conduct the required 1% manual tally for the June 2, 2026, Statewide Direct Primary Election, **Thursday, June 18, 2026, at 4:00 p.m. in the Board Chambers, Courthouse, Downieville, CA.**

This process is open to members of the public for observation. Observers shall not interfere with the counting of vote-by-mail ballots, including touching or handling of the ballots.

1 % MANUAL TALLY OVERVIEW

Random Selection of Precincts:

Serial numbered paper slips beginning with number 1 representing every voting precinct are placed into a box for random selection by a public observer, the elections official or a designated staff representative. Additional precincts are selected for other races not included in the initial 1 % random selection. This results in more than 1 % of the precincts being manually tallied for the election.

Manual Tally Summary Sheets are produced for entering the manual hand count during tally process. Staff performs a 1 % manual tally of voted precinct and vote by mail ballots in each precinct and records hand count results for comparison to automated count results for summary and tally reconciliation.

Ballots and Votes Cast (+) (-) differences between automated and manual results are recorded on 1 % Manual Tally Summary Sheets. Ballots and Votes Cast (+) (-) differences are reconciled by determining whether manual or computer count is correct. The tally board manually recounts the number of ballots and votes to re-verify actual number of ballots processed through system for comparison to Semi-Official Canvass Election Summary Report. Valid votes where clear voter intent can be determined are enhanced or duplicated pursuant to Uniform Vote Counting Standards.

A 1 % Manual Tally Recap Summary is prepared indicating automated ballot count and manual tally count differences for completed precincts. A final Summary Recap is provided for review and public distribution at the conclusion of the 1 % Manual Tally operations. A report on the 1 % Manual Tally results identifying discrepancies between automated and manual counts with an explanation of how discrepancies were resolved is submitted to the Secretary of State's Office.
