Three sets of labeled poker chips were created. One set had the batch numbers for vote by mail batches (882 chips), and a second batch representing each poll place (67 chips). A third set of poker chips was created with labels representing the one contest (1 chip). A member of the public would select a chip from the main bucket, and a chip representing which contest to audit in the batch.

22 vote by mail batches were selected and 6 poll place batches were selected. See attached report regarding this process.

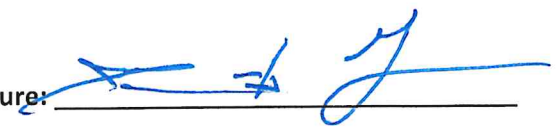

The Solano County Registrar of Voters (ROV) issued a public notice for random drawing of the minimum 1% Manual Tally per EC 15360 with the random selection to commence Monday June 15, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. No one from the public attended. The audit was conducted from Monday, June 15, 2026, through Wednesday, June 19, 2026.

The ROV audited Poll Place and Vote by Mail (VBM) ballots as separate categories as shown below:

Poll Place Manual Tally:

Six (6) Poll Places were randomly drawn for manual tally. A total of 18 out of 160 precincts comprised of 6 of 67 polling places were selected. This represents 1,715 (11.76%) of the total Election Day ballots cast for the election.

The manual tally confirmed the machine counts for all poll place ballots as follows:

Vote by Mail Manual Tally:

For VBM ballots, Solano County utilized batches of up to 250 ballots. 22 batches were randomly drawn for manual tally, representing 2,535 (2.66%) of the total VBM ballots cast for the election.

The manual tally confirmed the machine counts for all VBM ballots as follows:

Summary of Audit:

Overall, 6 of 67 poll places (8.95%) and 22 of 882 VBM batches (2.49%) were manually audited, representing 1,715 of 14,581 poll ballots (11.76%) and 2,535 of 95,440 VBM ballots cast (2.66%) respectively.

In each case, the hand count of ballots matched the machine count for the election.
