



Instructions for Tabulating and Reporting Election Results

October 8 is Student Mock Election Day!

If your school's schedule will make it difficult to hold the mock election on that day, you may conduct your voting early. Schools can begin reporting their results on October 1, all the way through midnight on Mock Election Day. Real time election results will be posted on the Student Mock Election website beginning at 5:00 p.m. on Student Mock Election Day. The final results will be announced on Friday, October 11, 2024.

How to Submit Your Results:

- Use the *School Vote Reporting Form* to tabulate your school's results.
- If voting will take place in classrooms, you are welcome to create your own classroom vote tally form or distribute a copy of the official Election Results Reporting Form to each teacher for use in tabulating the votes. Keep in mind that you will need to combine the classroom results into one campus-wide total before submitting them.
- Log-in to your school coordinator profile on the Secretary of State's website at [sos.ca.gov/elections/studentmockelection](https://www.sos.ca.gov/elections/studentmockelection). You will need your email and the password you created in order to log-in. If you have forgotten your password, click on the link that says, "I forgot my password" to have your password reset.
- Key in your school's vote totals and watch the live results webpage at <https://www.sos.ca.gov/elections/studentmockelection/mock-election-results> to see how your school's results compare to those from other schools around the state.
