1. Advertised on freeway billboards, radio, online and in print for VCRs to apply and highlighted the need for billingual speakers in each ad.
2. Postcards were mailed to 93,000+ households that included updated wording in regards to needing bilingual speakers.
3. Each citizen advisory committee meeting throughout 2022 with the VAAC, LAAC, & VEOAC were advised on the need of bilingual speakers as well as outreaching in various voter workshops given in second
languages.  4. Recruitment flyers were prepared in each language and sent to local shops and businesses to promote the recruitment of new poll workers.
