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Through more than three decades of working on behalf of the nonprofit, nonpartisan California Voter Foundation (www.calvoter.org), Kim Alexander advocates for election reforms that advance CVF's mission to improve the voting process to better serve voters. Major achievements include implementing online access to California campaign finance data, prohibiting paperless electronic voting, and requiring voter-verified paper ballots and post-election audits to give voters confidence in the accuracy of election results – all reforms that started in California and CVF also helped spread nationwide through networking, research and public relations. In response to growing threats and harassment of election officials and rising political violence, current priorities include improving election workers' safety and security, curtailing election mis- and disinformation, increasing funding and support for election administration and accelerating California's vote count. A fifth-generation Californian with deep roots in both Northern and Southern California, Kim lives in Sacramento and enjoys music festivals, community radio and all things California.
