PROP. 39 IS BIPARTISAN – NOT ABOUT DONALD TRUMP OR GAVIN NEWSOM

Prop. 39 gives California a bipartisan solution for election security. While politicians in D.C. fight over partisan control of elections, Californians can adopt our own solution: Voter ID.

Opponents will claim this measure is about Donald Trump or Gavin Newsom. It isn't. Prop. 39 is a California solution to growing mistrust in our elections.

Democrats, Republicans, and Nonpartisans encourage you to reject the big-money partisan allegations and vote yes on Prop 39 to encourage voter participation *and* protect our elections.

PROP. 39 SAVES MONEY

Prop. 39 saves millions of dollars each election by improving voter list accuracy and requiring independent audits to strengthen election management. Accurate voter rolls reduce printing and postage costs, while Voter ID helps streamline ballot processing and deliver quicker election results.

VOTER ID MAKES IT EASIER TO VOTE

Prop. 39 keeps voting easy while making it more secure. It includes privacy protections and prohibits burdens on voters. States with voter ID laws have not seen decreases in voter participation. When voters trust elections, participation increases.
