

BALLOT LABEL

**PROHIBITS CITIZENS FROM VOTING UNLESS THEY PRESENT GOVERNMENT-
ISSUED IDENTIFICATION. INITIATIVE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT.**

Invalidates mail ballots that do not have last four digits of designated government-issued identification number written on envelope. Prohibits in-person voting without presenting government-issued identification. **Fiscal Impact:** Costs of between tens of millions of dollars and low hundreds of millions of dollars each year to implement new voting requirements.
