

#### **TRENDS**

Statewide Special Election 60-Day Report of Registration:

- The total voter registration in the state is 23,061,263.
- The percentage of eligible Californians who are registered to vote is 84.78%.
- The percentage of voters who have no party preference is 22.55%.
- The percentage of voters registered with a qualified political party is 76.41%.
- The percentage of voters registered with the Democratic Party is 44.96%.
- The percentage of voters registered with the Republican Party is 25.26%.

Preregistered voters may be activated before their 18th birthday if they will be 18 in an upcoming election. Those pre-registered voters were not eliminated from pre-registration statistics since they remain pre-registrants until their 18th birthday. Therefore, some voters are counted in both pre-registration and active registration statistics.
