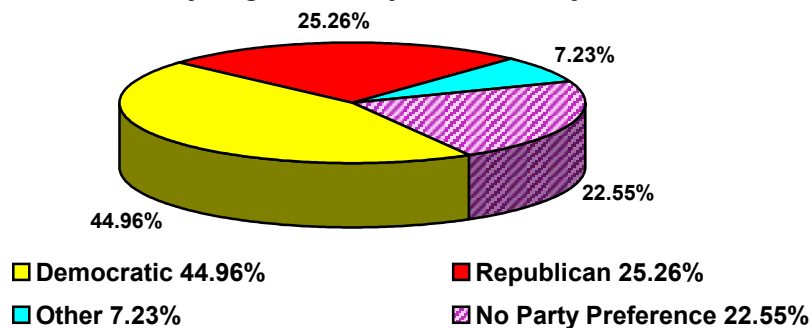

### TRENDS

Statewide Special Election 60-Day Report of Registration:

- The total voter registration in the state is 23,061,263.
- The percentage of eligible Californians who are registered to vote is 84.78%.
- The percentage of voters who have no party preference is 22.55%.
- The percentage of voters registered with a qualified political party is 76.41%.
- The percentage of voters registered with the Democratic Party is 44.96%.
- The percentage of voters registered with the Republican Party is 25.26%.

<sup>1</sup>Since September 26, 2016, 16- and 17-year-olds can pre-register to vote. Once they turn 18, they become automatically registered. Pre-registered voters may be activated before their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday if they will be 18 in an upcoming election. Those pre-registered voters were not eliminated from pre-registration statistics since they remain pre-registrants until their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday. Therefore, some voters are counted in both pre-registration and active registration statistics.

<sup>2</sup>Historical pre-registration totals show how many people pre-registered to vote since pre-registration began on September 26, 2016, including pre-registered voters who have since turned 18 and have become active voters.
