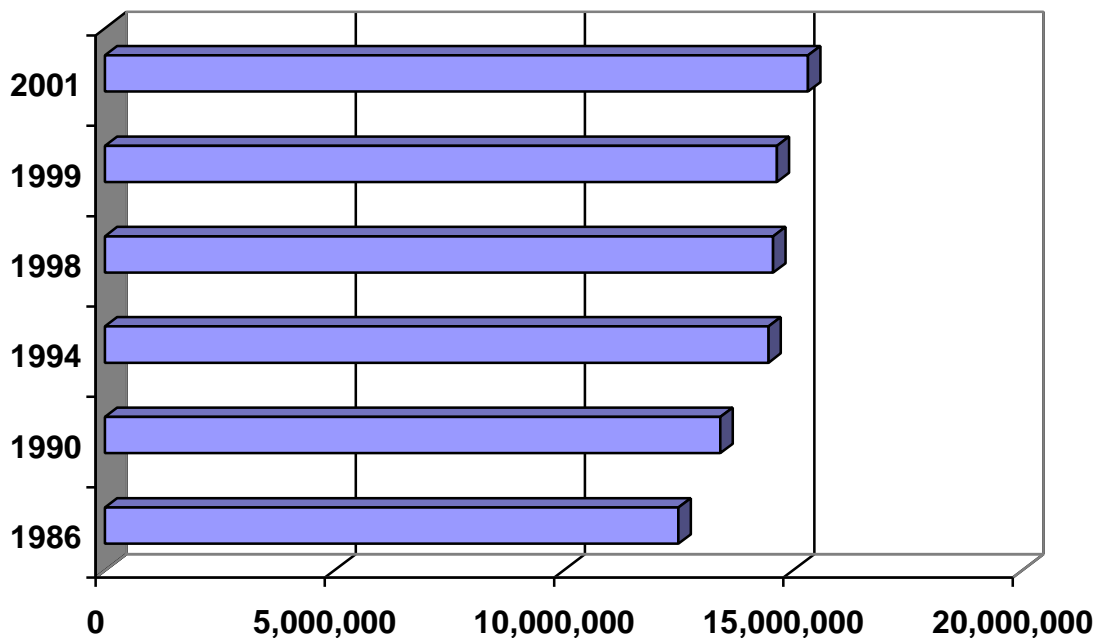

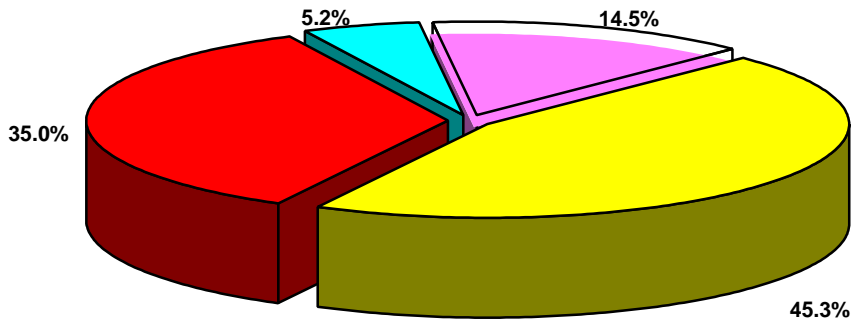

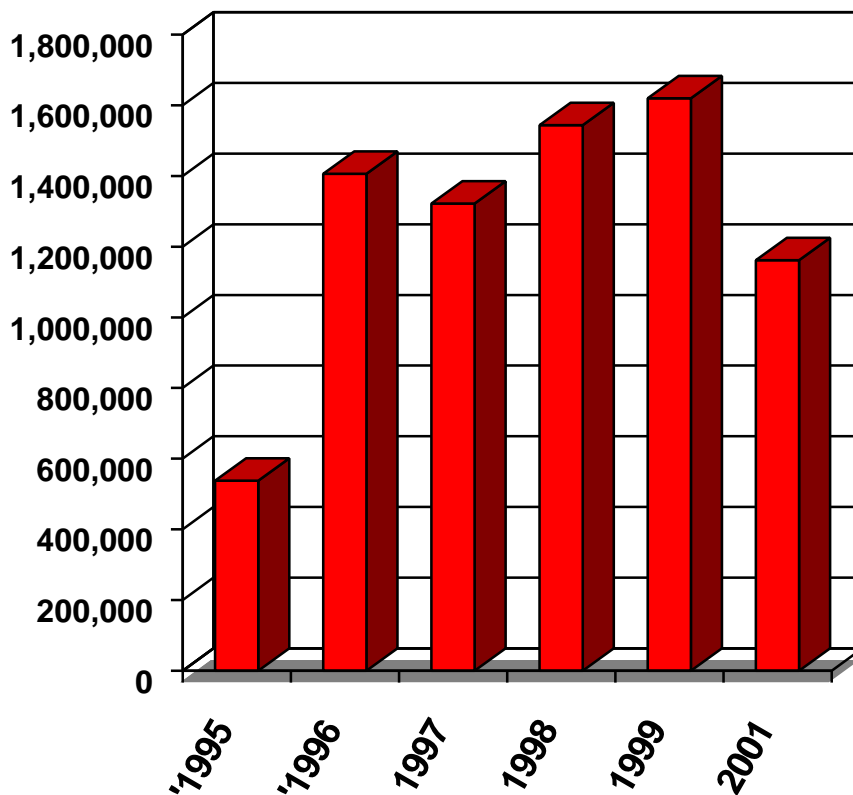
**October 2, 2001 Report of Registration
154-Day Close**

TRENDS:

Since the December 5, 1999 (154-Day) Report of Registration:

- the percentage of total registration in the state has increased to 71.8% from 69.5%;
- registration in the qualified political parties declined from 86.4% to 84.6%;
- registration in the Democratic party declined from 46.3% to 45.3%;
- registration in the Republican party remained at 35.0%;
- the Declined to State count has increased from 13.5% to 14.5%; and
- since June 19, 1995 (when NVRA began), through September 2001, 9,207,378 people have registered or reregistered in conjunction with "Motor Voter"
