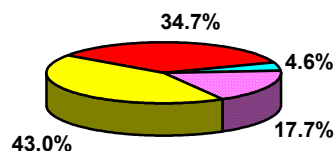

October 18, 2004 Registration Percentages



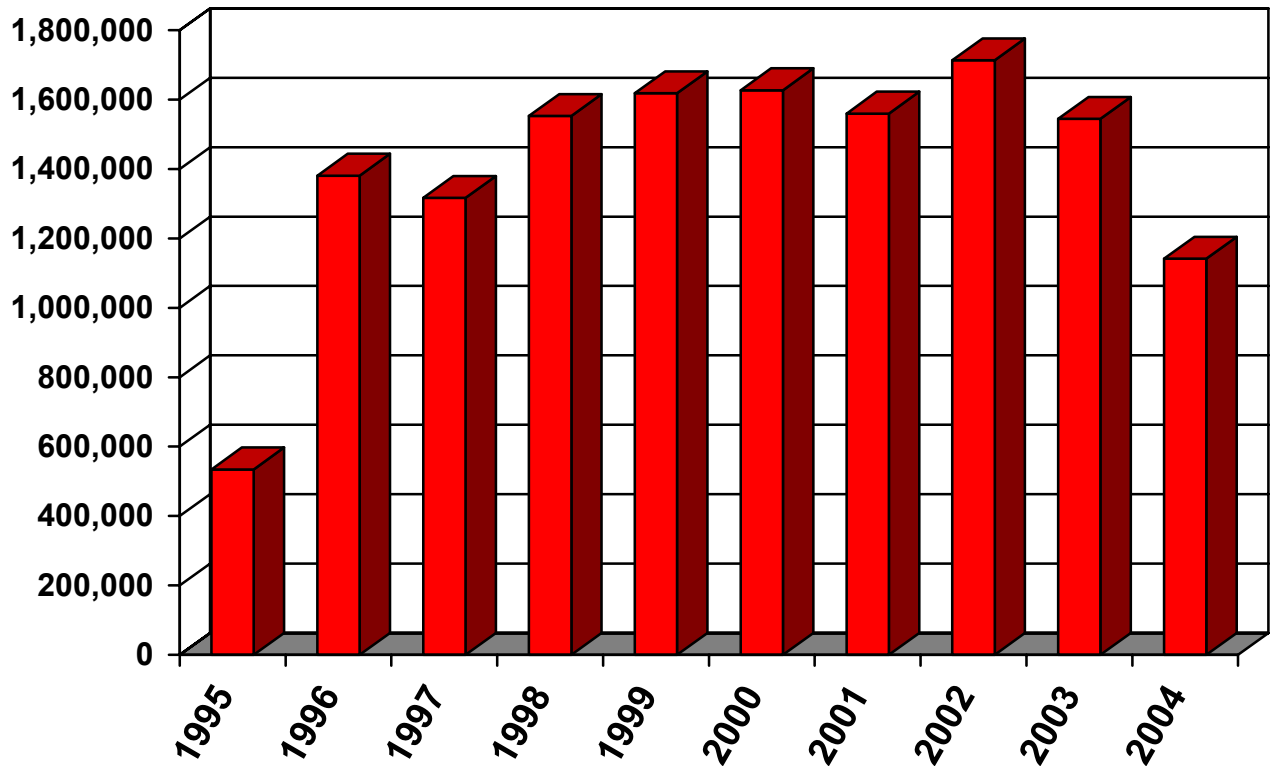
■ Democratic 43.0%

**REPORT OF REGISTRATION
OCTOBER 18, 2004**

Since the October 10, 2000 (29-Day) Report of Registration:

- The total registration in the state has increased from 15,707,307 to 16,557,273.
- The percentage number of total registered voters compared to eligible voters has increased from 73.2% to 75.0%.
- The percentage number of voters who have “Declined to State” their political party has increased from 14.4% to 17.7%.
- The percentage registration in the qualified political parties has declined from 84.8% to 81.8%.
- The percentage registration in the Democratic Party declined from 45.4% to 43.0%.
- The percentage registration in the Republican Party declined from 34.9% to 34.7%.
- Since June 19, 1995 (when NVRA began) through August 31, 2004, 13,990,311 people have registered or reregistered in conjunction with “Motor Voter.”
