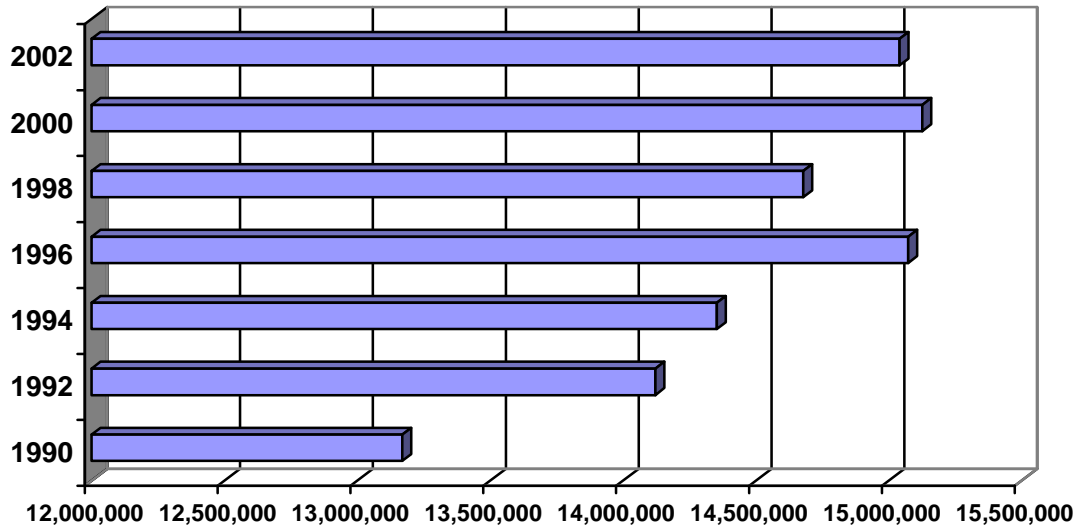

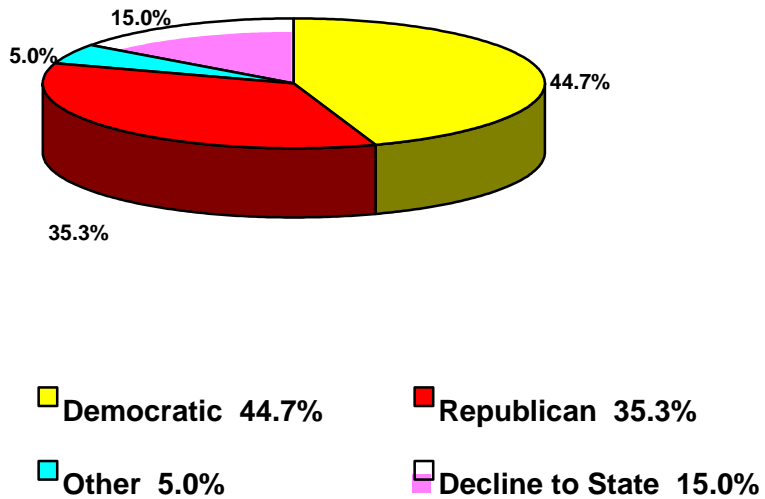

**September 6, 2002 Registration Percentages**



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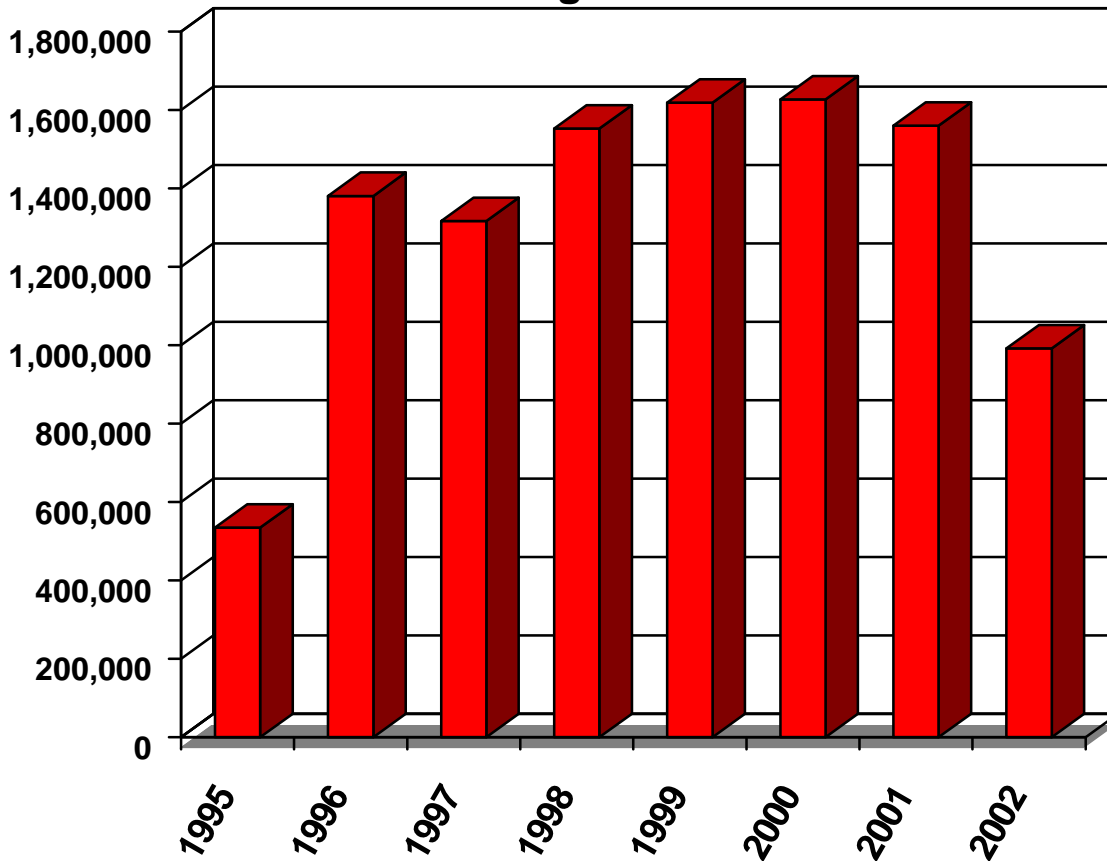
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### TRENDS:

Since the September 8, 2000 (60-Day) Report of Registration:

- the percentage of total registration in the state has declined from 70.58% to 70.23%;
- registration in the qualified political parties has declined from 84.87% to 84.23%;
- registration in the Democratic party declined from 45.54% to 44.73%;
- registration in the Republican party increased from 34.95% to 35.27%;
- the number of voters who have declined to state has increased from 14.23% to 14.98%; and
- since 6/19/95 (when NVRA began) through July 31, 2002, 10,582,470 people have registered or reregistered in conjunction with "Motor Voter"
