

**September 8, 2006 Registration Percentages**




■ Democratic 42.7%

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Since last 60-day Gubernatorial General Report of Registration (September 6, 2002 Report):

- The total registration in the state has increased from 15,041,203 to 15,614,659.
- The percentage number of total registered voters compared to eligible voters has declined from 70.2% to 69.0%.
- The percentage number of voters who have “Declined to State” their political party has increased from 15.0% to 18.6%.
- The percentage registration in the qualified political parties has declined from 84.2% to 80.9%.
- The percentage registration in the Democratic Party declined from 44.7% to 42.7%.
- The percentage registration in the Republican Party declined from 35.3% to 34.3%
- Since June 19, 1995, (when NVRA began) through July 31, 2006, 17,403,852 people have registered or reregistered to vote in conjunction with “Motor Voter.”
