# 60-DAY REPORT OF REGISTRATION <br> September 5, 2014, for the November 4, 2014, General Election 

## TRENDS

Since the last 60-day Report of Registration for a General Election in a gubernatorial election year (September 3, 2010):

- The total voter registration in the state increased from $16,993,075$ to $17,634,876$.
- The percentage of the total number of registered voters compared to the number of people who are eligible to register to vote increased from $72.2 \%$ to $72.7 \%$.
- The percentage of voters who have no party preference increased from $20.2 \%$ to $23.1 \%$.
- The percentage of people registered with a qualified political party decreased from $79.1 \%$ to $76.1 \%$.
- The percentage of voters registered with the Democratic Party decreased from $44.3 \%$ to $43.4 \%$.
- The percentage of voters registered with the Republican Party decreased from 30.9\% to 28.2\%.
