## Effective Date

"An initiative ... approved by a majority of votes thereon takes effect the day after the election unless the measure provides otherwise ....." See Cal. Const., Art. II, Sec. 10.

"A proposed [legislative] amendment or revision shall be submitted to the electors and if approved by a majority of votes thereon takes effect the day after the election unless the measure provides otherwise". See Cal. Const., Art. XVIII, Sec. 4.

Bond proposals submitted to the electors by the Legislature also become effective the day following approval by a majority of votes thereon. See Cal. Const., Art. XVI, Sec. 1.
