1. **DFM Mark-a-Vote:** Butte, Contra Costa, Lake, Madera, San Joaquin, Santa Cruz, Sonoma, and Sutter.
2. **ES&S Optech Eagle:** Amador, Kings, Mariposa, Mono, Placer, San Francisco, and San Mateo.
3. **ES&S 350/550:** Merced, Nevada and Tuolumne.
4. **Global Accu-Vote ES-2000:** Fresno, Humboldt, Lassen, Marin, San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara, Siskiyou ,Trinity, and Tulare.

## B. Punch Card

1. **Datavote:** Alpine, Calaveras, Colusa, Del Norte, El Dorado, Glenn, Imperial, Inyo, Kern, Modoc, Monterey, Napa, Orange, Plumas, San Benito, Sierra, Stanislaus, Tehama, Ventura, Yolo, and Yuba.
2. **Votomatic:** Alameda, Los Angeles, Mendocino, San Diego, Shasta, and Solano.
3. **Pollstar:** Sacramento, San Bernardino and Santa Clara.
