

ABOUT THIS STATEMENT OF VOTE

The Introduction

This Statement of Vote contains a wealth of information. In the introductory pages, you will find the voter registration and participation statistics reported by county for this election and statewide for past general elections starting with the November 8, 1910 election. The list of voting systems used by the counties is next, followed by information about the contests on the ballot. The last section in the introduction contains the summaries of votes cast for ballot measures and for all offices and measures on the statewide ballot.

The Statement of the Vote

The Statement of Vote reports the county-by-county vote cast for each candidate and measure on the ballot. The vote is reported by all 58 counties, listed in alphabetical order with the statewide total at the bottom. Candidates are listed in alphabetical order.
