November 2, 2004 Presidential General Election Supplement to the Statement of Vote

EXPLANATORY NOTES

This Supplement to the Statement of Vote contains the official vote results for the November 2, 2004 Presidential Election as provided to the Secretary of State's Office by the counties.

Calaveras and Imperial Counties
The amount of the unapportioned absentee

must be added to the sum of the vote results in the supervisorial districts to match the county total.

County vote reporting system does not apportion absentee voters back to their respective supervisorial districts.

Monterey County

The sum of the vote results in the supervisorial districts is less than the county total for some Presidential and US Senate candidates.

County vote reporting system was programmed to identify overseas voter ballots as a unique, federal-only precinct. These federal-only precincts were not included in the supervisorial precinct report.

Napa County

The sum of the vote results in the supervisorial districts is less than the county total; however, when the unapportioned absentee votes are added, that total exceeds the county total.

County vote reporting system does not apportion absentee voters back to their respective supervisorial districts.

San Luis Obispo County

The sum of the vote results in the supervisorial districts is less than the county total.

In the county's Official Canvass, these "multiple districts" votes make up the difference between the supervisorial districts and the county total. County vote reporting system programmed mail ballot precincts by ballot type. Some of these ballot types crossed supervisorial district lines. These ballot types were consolidated into a line item called "multiple districts."
