NOMINATING PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES AT THE PRIMARY ELECTION

On or before the 120th day before the presidential primary election, the Secretary of State announces the names of the candidates she has selected to appear on the ballot for the office of President of the United States. Selection is based on a number of factors, including whether a candidate:

- Participates in candidate debates;
- Actively campaigns in California;
- Appears in public opinion polls; and/or
- Qualifies for federal campaign matching funds.

Candidates not selected by the Secretary of State may qualify by circulating petitions statewide to gather signatures of voters registered in their party, generally 1% of their party's statewide registration total; however, the Democratic Party requires that Democratic candidates must gather signatures in each of the state's 53 congressional districts, equal in number to 1% of the district's Democratic registration or 500, whichever is fewer.

By the 120th day before the primary election, the chairperson of each qualified party must notify the SOS of the number of delegates who will represent California at the party's national nominating convention. Prior to the primary election, each candidate files a slate of the requisite number of delegates for his/her party, selected according to the party's requirements.

Although only the names of the presidential candidates appear on the primary election ballot, voters actually are casting ballots for the slate of delegates pledged to the candidate of their choice. The slate pledged to the winning candidate goes to the party's national nominating convention. At the convention, the duly elected delegates from all states elect their party's nominee and then notify the Secretary of State.

**INITIATIVE AND REFERENDUM
QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS IN 2007, 2008, 2009, AND 2010**

(Based on the number of votes cast for the office of Governor at the 2006 General Election)

Initiative

The initiative process is the power of the people to place statutes and constitutional amendments on the ballot. These measures can either create or change statutes (including general obligation bonds) or amend the California Constitution. If the initiative proposes to amend California statutes, the proponents must gather petition signatures of registered voters equal to 5% of the total votes cast for Governor in the last gubernatorial election. If the initiative proposes to amend the California Constitution, the signature requirement is 8%. A qualified initiative is placed on the ballot at a regularly scheduled statewide election that occurs at least 131 days after the measure qualifies, or at a special election called by the Governor.

An initiative requires a simple majority of the public's vote to be enacted. A "yes" vote approves and a "no" vote rejects a proposed statute or constitutional amendment placed on the ballot through the initiative process.

Referendum

Referendum is the power of the people to approve or reject statutes already adopted by their Legislature. However, this does not apply to statutes that have urgency clauses, call for elections, or provide for tax levies or appropriations for current expenses of the state. Voters wishing to prevent a legislatively adopted statute from taking effect must – within 90 days of enactment of the bill – gather signatures of registered voters equal to 5% of the total votes cast for Governor in the last gubernatorial election. A qualified referendum is placed on the ballot at a regularly scheduled statewide election that occurs at least 31 days after the measure qualifies, or at a special election called by the Governor.

A "yes" vote approves a statute previously adopted by the Legislature and allows it to take effect. A "no" vote rejects the statute that had been adopted by the Legislature and prevents it from taking effect.

**NEW POLITICAL PARTY QUALIFICATION
REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 2008 AND 2010 PRIMARY ELECTIONS**
(Based on the number of persons who voted at the 2006 General Election)

There are two methods by which political parties can qualify for official status which enables them to place candidates on a primary election ballot. The qualification deadline for either method is 135 days before a statewide primary in an even-numbered year, based on the registration totals as of the 154th day before that election.

1. **Registration.** No later than 135 days before the primary election, a party must have obtained registrations equal in number to 1% of the total vote cast in the last gubernatorial election. The current registration requirement is 88,991 [1% of 8,899,059 (Elections Code section 5100(b))]

2. **Petition.** No later than 135 days before the primary election, a party must have collected petition signatures of registered voters of any party equal in number to 10% of the total vote cast in the last gubernatorial election. The current signature requirement is 889,906 [10% of 8,899,059 (Elections Code section 5100(c))]

To retain its official status, a political party must maintain a registration level equal to 1/15 of 1% (0.00067) of the total registration of the state at all times [Elections Code section 5101]. In addition, after each gubernatorial election, party qualifications are reviewed. To retain its official status after the election, a party must:

1. Maintain a registration level equal to at least 1% of the entire vote of the state at the last gubernatorial election [Elections Code section 5100(b)]; or

2. Have a candidate for statewide office (Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Controller, Treasurer, Attorney General, Insurance Commissioner, or United States Senator) receive at least 2% of the vote for that office [Elections Code section 5100(a)].
