

**June 8, 2010, Primary Election
Supplement to the Statement of Vote**

Explanatory Notes

This Supplement to the Statement of Vote contains the official vote results for the June 8, 2010, Primary Election as provided to the Secretary of State's Office by California's 58 counties.

Marin

Marin County uses ballot types that cross supervisorial district lines. These ballot types have been consolidated into a line item called "multiple districts."

San Benito

The total yes votes for Proposition 13 in the Statement of Vote was incorrectly entered. The correct total number of yes votes for Proposition 13 is 8,677 instead of 6,677. This Supplement to the Statement of Vote reflects the corrected vote total.

The vote total in the Statement of Vote for one of the candidates for Treasurer, Edward Teyssier, was incorrectly entered. The correct vote total is 19 instead of 18. This Supplement to the Statement of Vote reflects the corrected vote total.

San Luis Obispo

San Luis Obispo County uses ballot types that cross district lines. These ballot types have been consolidated into a line item called "multiple districts."

Solano

The vote total in the Statement of Vote for one of the candidates for Superintendent of Public Instruction, Diane Lenning, was incorrectly entered. The correct vote total is 5,796 instead of 5,795. This Supplement to the Statement of Vote reflects the corrected vote total.

Ventura

In Ventura County multiple precincts were consolidated into one precinct with multiple ballot styles containing Senate Districts 17, 19, and 23. Ventura County is unable to determine which Senate District the votes for these statewide candidates and ballot measures in this precinct should be attributed. However, the county totals are accurate, though they will not match the sum total of the three Senate Districts.
