- Every active registered voter will receive a vote-by-mail ballot for the 2024 Primary and General Elections
- Check or update your voter registration information as early as possible at RegisterToVote.ca.gov/?t=s to ensure your vote-by-mail ballot is sent to the correct address



Choose How You Will Vote: _____

- **Voting by Mail:** This is a secure and safe way to return your ballot
- **Voting in Person:** In-person locations offer important resources such as Same Day Voter Registration, ADA accommodations, replacement ballots, and other support in various languages



Identify When and Where You Will Vote: _____

- **Early in Person:** Counties in California will be offering early in-person voting opportunities; visit CAEarlyVoting.sos.ca.gov to find your nearest polling location
- **Early by Mail:** Sign and mail your ballot as soon as you complete it; completed vote-by-mail ballots must be postmarked on or before Election Day
- **Secured Drop Box:** The secure drop box shall be clearly and visibly marked as an “Official Ballot Drop Box” that shows language stating that tampering with the drop box is a felony
- **Election Day:** Voting Locations are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Election Day; if you are in line by the closing time, then you have a right to vote
