The following are the action items from the April 10, 2024, meeting of the Voting Accessibility Advisory Committee (VAAC):

1. Increase the number of pre-registered voters in youth demographic.
2. Increase voting in the Deaf community and accessibility.
3. Working group results for petition process accessible for those who have a disability.
4. Streamlining RAVBM process, create documents explaining how to interact with voters with disabilities.
5. Safe at home program – enhancing processes for those with disabilities – RAVBM cannot be used by visually impaired voters.
6. Working on outreach efforts to inform the general public of the VAAC to gather feedback/input. Work with other local VAACs.
7. AB 545 - ask for feedback from the counties on how curb-site voting went in the recent election.
8. See how the VAAC can increase the turnout for voters with disabilities.
9. Review how counties select vote centers; encourage counties to make sure all vote centers and polling places are accessible to all voters.
10. Increasing VAAC participation throughout all counties.
11. Develop a local VAAC for San Luis Obispo County; looking to collaborate with other counties on how to get a county level VAAC started.
12. Develop more knowledge of local accessibility organizations and their representatives to create a platform for them to engage community members with the VAAC.
13. Have the SOS survey how people's experience was.
