### Vote by mail:

Return your ballot by mail  
**as soon as you receive it.**

### Use a drop box:

Return your ballot to a secure  
drop off location in any county  
**up to 28 days before the  
election.**

### Vote center:

- Vote in person anywhere in the county **up to 10 days before the election**
- Register to vote and vote same-day
- Drop off your ballot
