

BACK-UP PLANS FOR COUNTIES REQUIRED BY FEDERAL COURT TO CONVERT TO A NEW VOTING SYSTEM BY MARCH 1,2004

(The Application for Funding Consideration requires each of the 9 counties currently using Votomatic or PollStar voting equipment to indicate their plan for conversion, and their back up plan should it be needed.)

<u>COUNTY</u>	<u>PROPOSED BACK UP PLAN</u>
Alameda	Conversion and testing of touch screen voting system in 2002
Los Angeles	Phased conversion; interim paper-based voting system for 2004, touch screen system after that
Mendocino	Plan to convert to touch screen for 2004; back up system will be Datavote
Sacramento	Plan to convert to touch screen for 2004; back-up system will be optical scan
San Bernardino	Plan to convert to touch screen for 2004; back-up system will be optical scan
San Diego	Plan to convert to touch screen for 2004; back-up system will be optical scan
Santa Clara	Plan to convert to touch screen; pilot project to test 3 systems for 11/02 with full implementation for 11/03. No other system as back up
Shasta	Plan to convert to touch screen for the 11/03 election. No back-up system identified.
Solano	Plan to convert to touch screen for 2004; back-up system will be optical scan.
